FLOATING SHELF INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Contents:

- 1- Floating Shelf
- 4- #10x3" mounting screws
- 1 or 2 Custom Mounting Brackets depending on size

These instructions are for mounting the floating shelf to a standard 2 x 4 wood stud wall. Other types of wall construction may require different mounting methods. Floating shelves may be trimmed up to $\frac{3}{4}$ " on each side for between wall installations. The recommended weight capacity of a properly installed floating shelf is 25 pounds.

- 1) Locate the desired position of the floating shelf then locate the center of the studs behind the wall.
- 2) Draw a level line across the wall to locate the top of the mounting bracket.
- 3) Use the supplied screws to fasten the mounting bracket into wall studs.

NOTE: Our custom engineered wall mount bracket is designed to give you the best possible chance of hitting 2 wall studs per bracket. It is recommended that each mounting bracket be fastened directly to the wall studs in two places using the supplied screws. If this is not possible then at least 1 wall stud should be fastened to and an appropriate wall anchor be used in two other places. When using the supplied screws with a #2 square drive bit, it is not necessary to pre-drill holes into the wall studs.

- 4) Check that the mounting bracket is level.
- 5) Slide the floating shelf over the bracket until it meets the wall.

NOTE: There is some side to side adjustment in the mounting bracket and the Floating Shelf
