



ATTENTION:


- · Always rest glass on a leveled surface.
- The glass panels are tempered and cannot be cut.
- Fiberglass, acrylic or sheetrock construction might not be sufficiently strong enough to support the shower door enclosure. You should use the wood framing from behind the face edge of the stall to provide a secure mounting to the door. Apply a bead of silicone between the walls and base of the stall.
- For optimum performance, you should install the shower door perfectly level on a level surface.
- By not leveling the unit during construction the unit may leak causing possible water damage.





Place the bottom of the anchor (H) at 75 1/4" from the floor at the wall and use a pencil to mark the holes accurately.


Use a Ø8 drill bit to make the holes.


Insert the anchor on the holes.


Secure the wall anchor with the provided screws (G)







Insert both brackets (B) into the Sliding Rail (F)


Insert Rail brackets into the Wall bracket.



Tighten the 4 screws with the provided allen key.

Insert door stopper (C) in to the installed wall bracket (B)

Slide the threshold (O) trough the clip of the guide block (P).

4.2

Place the bottom guide block (P) and the threshold clips (N) on the floor and use a pencil to mark the holes accurately.


NOTE: Make sure that the guide block is in the center of the space.


4.3

Drill the holes using a Ø6 drill bit.

4.4

Insert the anchors (Q) into the holes, then tighten the bottom guide block (P) with screws (M).





LEFT DOOR


Insert both single rollers (**D**) with the washers on the glass door holes.

Insert the door handle (K) in the door holes.

3.

Insert the flanged seal strips (J) on both sides of the glass door (E) tightly.


Insert both single rollers (D) with the washers on the glass door holes.



Insert the door (E) into the bottom guide block (P), then place the wheel on the sliding rail (F).

7.2


Adjust the door height turning the rollers (D) up or down with the allen key provided to level the doors.


7.3

When the final position is set, tighten the rollers (D) and finish the assembly with the roller cap.

7.4


Insert the roller guides (I) with the washers on the glass door holes.




