- · Do not make or alter any holes in the wiring enclosure or modify any electrical components.


CAUTIONS


- The fixture must be wired in accordance with the National Electric Code (N.E.C) standards and any applicable local codes or ordinances.
- Supply conductors must at least be rated for 90°C/194°F.
- Suitable for operation in ambient not exceeding 45°C.
- Suitable for wet locations.
- · Caution Risk of fire.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Ensure the power has been turned off by switching the circuit breaker to the off position or by removing the fuse from the fuse panel.
- 2. Secure the hanging hook to the back of the light by tightening the hook into specified location and tighten the set screw.
- 3. Remove the switch cover to preview and select a color temperature and power consumption.
- 3. Loosen the retaining screw on the hanging hook and hang the fixture on chain or eye bolt (not included).
- 4. Tighten the retaing screw to secure the fixture.
- 5. Using the supplied wire nuts, connect the black (hot) wire from the fixture to the black (hot) supply wire. Connect the white (neutral) wire from the fixture to the white (neutral) supply wire. Connect the green (ground) wire from the fixture to the green/bare copper (ground) supply wire.
- 6. Tuck all wires carefully into the junction box, ensuring no wires are pinched or have exposed strands. Ensure the junction box is covered.
- 7. Restore power and ensure proper operation of the fixture.

Note: Ensure the eye bolt or chain and supporting structure have an appropriate strength rating of 3.5-4 pounds.
