TORK, INC. warrants its TORKALERT™ Signaling Devices to be free of defects in material and workmanship under normal use for a period of two (2) years from date of manufacture, except motors for rotating beacons and strobe flash tubes which are warranted for one (1) year. TORK, INC. reserves the right to change designs or materials without prior notice as it may deem necessary. Liability under this written warranty and under implied warranties is limited to the repair or replacement, without charge, at TORK, INC.'s option, of any defective unit or part thereof, for the original user only, and only if the defective unit or parts is returned to TORK, INC. at 1 Grove St., Mount Vernon, NY 10550, freight prepaid within the time period of the warranty as indicated above.

TORK, INC.'s liability shall in no event exceed the purchase price paid by the original user. This warranty is void if the unit has been improperly installed or altered or damaged through misuse or by accident, neglect, misapplication, fire, flood, or Acts of God.
