25 YEAR RESIDENTIAL WARRANTY (WEAR, STAINING AND FADING)

DIP Design Is Personal Laminate warrants to the original purchaser that the surface wear layer on products will not wear through, stain or fade from sunlight or artificial light for 25 years in a residential environment from the date of purchase. If the product wears through*, fades or stains, DIP Design Is Personal Laminate will repair or replace, at its option, the affected flooring material. This warranty includes the repair or replacement of defective material only, exclusive of all labor charges. Should the original floor design be discontinued, DIP Design Is Personal Laminate will replace the defective material with one of equal value. This warranty is exclusive and in lieu of all other warranties, expressed or implied, and all other remedies, guarantees, or liabilities arising by law or otherwise.

*The surface wear must be evident, measuring at least 2 square inches and not be the result of any items listed in the Exclusion section. Loss of gloss is not surface wear.



WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS

The owner must inspect for color, finish and quality before installation. DIP Design Is Personal Laminate cannot be held responsible for costs incurred when a floor with visible defects has been installed. The warranty does not cover wear or damage caused by improper installation, negligence, water, erosion, abrasion, extreme heat or temperature conditions, cleaning, care or maintenance in a manner contrary to the instructions as provided by DIP Design Is Personal Laminate, physical freight damage, alteration, or any wear or damage caused by acts of God. The warranty does not apply if the product is installed in areas where condensation may occur repeatedly. Under no circumstances can DIP Design Is Personal Laminate be held responsible for damages, loss of time, inconvenience, expenses or costs caused by or resulting directly or indirectly from a problem about which a claim has been or may be made herein, including any warranty of merchantability or suitability of the Product for a particular purpose. Because certain provinces or states do not allow exclusions or limitations of indirect damages, the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

This warranty provides you with specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which may vary according to state or province. To make a claim, contact your DIP Design Is Personal Laminate dealer no later than 30 days following the date of discovery of the defect. Proof of purchase, such as bill of sale, is mandatory when requesting warranty service.

- DIP Design Is Personal Laminate reserves the right to designate a representative to inspect the floor and remove samples for analysis.
- No unauthorized person, fabricator or installer, agent of employee of DIP Design Is Personal Laminate, or
 any representative is entitled to assume liability on behalf of DIP Design Is Personal Laminate relating in the
 sale of this product or has the authority to increase or alter the obligations or limitations of this warranty.

WHAT DIP DESIGN IS PERSONAL LAMINATE WILL DO SHOULD YOU NEED WARRANTY SERVICE:

If DIP Design Is Personal Laminate honors a claim under this limited warranty, it will repair or replace, at its option, the cost of the affected flooring material. If professionally installed, DIP Design Is Personal Laminate will pay the reasonable labor costs to perform the replacement or repair during the first two (2) years from the date of the original purchase.
