- Do not exceed 350 lb weight capacity. Do not exceed drawer capacity, 75 lb per connected pair of slides. Evenly distribute load from bottom up. Uneven loading cause tipping. Be aware of dynamic loading! Sudden load movement may briefly create excess load causing tipping.
- Close and lock drawer before moving. Do not pull. push to move.
- Use only on a flat, level, hard and smooth surface capable of safely supporting a fully loaded unit.
 Use care when rolling over concrete seams.
- Do not lift using handle(s).Do not lift while loaded.

- 7. Do not use for food preparation or service.
- 8. Lock Swivel Casters after moving.
- Do not mount on truck bed or any other moving object.
- 10. Use as intended only.
- Wear ANSI-approved safety goggles and heavy-duty work gloves during assembly.
- 12. Inspect before every use; do not use if parts are loose or damaged.
- 13. Maintain product labels and nameplates. These carry important safety information. If unreadable or missing, contact Harbor Freight Tools for a replacement.






- 1. Assemble on a flat, level, hard and smooth surface capable of safely supporting a fully loaded Cart.
- 2. Attach two Swivel Casters (7) to one side of Lower Shelf (5), using eight Carriage Bolts (11), Washers (15), and Lock Nuts (13).
- 3. Attach two Locking Swivel Casters (8) to other side, using eight Carriage Bolts (11), Washers (15), and Lock Nuts (13).




- 4. Fully open drawer.
- Move the release levers on both slides to release the drawer. Push the release lever on the left slide down, and pull the release lever on the right slide up.




 Attach Upper Shelf (2) to Drawer Frame (1), using four Bolts (12), eight Washers (15), and four Lock Nuts (13).




- 7. Lock Locking Swivel Casters.
- 8. Attach one Post (3) to each corner of Drawer/Shelf assembly and Lower Shelf, using twenty four Bolts (10), Washers (16) and Lock Nuts (14) total, eight on top and sixteen on the bottom, as shown below.



- 9. Attach one Handle (6) to each end, using eight Bolts (9), Washers (16), and Lock Nuts (14).
- 10. Tighten all hardware.
- 11. Reinstall Drawer (4) into Drawer Frame.

- Fill Cart evenly, from bottom to top. Do not exceed weight capacities.
- 2. Close and lock Drawer.
- 3. Unlock Locking Swivel Casters.

- Roll Cart to a flat, level, hard and smooth surface capable of safely supporting a fully loaded Cart. Do not roll Cart over concrete seams or other rough/uneven surfaces.
- 5. Lock Locking Swivel Casters.

Maintenance and Servicing


