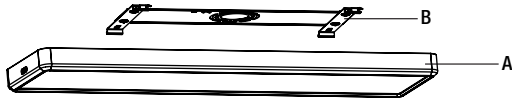

NOTE: Keep your receipt and these instructions for proof of purchase.

WARNING: RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK. Ensure the electricity to the wires you are working on is shut off. Either remove the fuse or turn off the circuit breaker before removing an existing light fixture or installing the new one.

If you are unfamiliar with electrical installations, we recommend you contact a qualified electrician to do the installation.

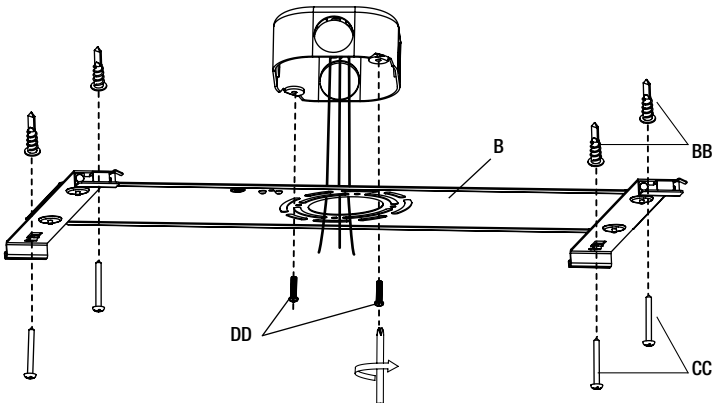
INSTALLATION

NOTE: Select a suitable location that can support the weight of the fixture. Determine the method for mounting the fixture before drilling, based on the type of ceiling.

NOTE: Two people are recommended for the installation of this light fixture.

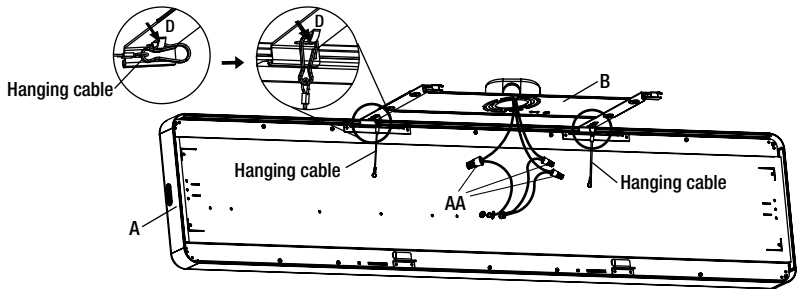
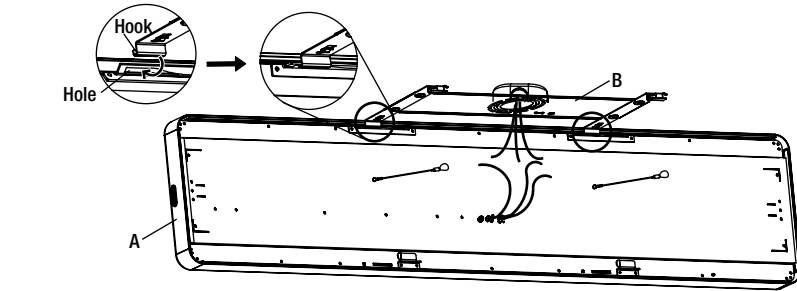
- Open the package and remove the lamps, then remove the mounting bracket (B). Mount the mounting bracket (B) to the electrical box using the two electrical box screws (DD).
- Mark four holes locations for mounting, then remove the mounting bracket (B). Drill four 1/8-in. pilot hole into the screw locations marked on the ceiling. You can also use an awl or nail to dimple the screw holes. Install a drywall anchor (BB) and a mounting screw (CC) in each drilled mounting hole to tighten the mounting bracket (B).

NOTE: Do not need drill hole on wooden surface.

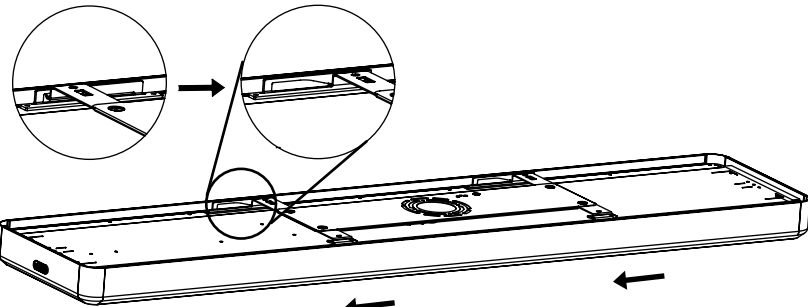


INSTALLATION (CONTINUED)

- Hang the two holes on the left side of fixture body (A) to the two hooks on the front end of mounting bracket (B) at the same time.
- Hang the two hanging cables on the lamp at the D place of the mounting bracket (B). Connect the hot and neutral (black and white) wires from the J-box to the same color wires from the fixture body (A). Connect the green wire from the J-box to the grounding wire from fixture body (A) and mounting bracket (B). Cover the wire connections using the wire connectors (AA). Make sure to fasten them well.



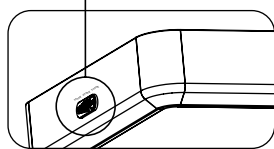
- Level the top of the whole fixture body (A) to the ceiling, then slide the fixture to the left, and then check whether the fixture is installed firmly.



- Turn on the power and light the lamp, and move the toggle switch to the desired color temperature gear (as shown below, 5000 K left 4000 K right 3000 K).

NOTE: The factory setting for the correlated color temperature (CCT) is 3000K, which is the warmest white light.

- Put the lamps and lanterns, turn on the power supply can all function normally.



CARE AND CLEANING

CAUTION: Before attempting to clean the tube and luminaire/light fixture, disconnect the power to the fixture by turning the breaker off or removing the fuse from the fuse box. Clean with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use cleaners with chemicals, solvents, or harsh abrasives. Do not use liquid cleaner on the LEDs, LED driver, or wiring.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Minor problems often can be fixed without the help of an electrician.

WARNING: Before doing any work on the fixture, disconnect power to the light fixture.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The fixture will not light.	The power is off.	Ensure the power supply is on.
	The circuit breaker is off.	Ensure the circuit breaker is in the on position.
	There is a bad connection.	Check to ensure proper wire connections are made. Contact a qualified electrician.
	There is a defective switch.	Contact a qualified electrician.
The fuse blows or the circuit breaker trips when the light is turned on.	The wires are crossed or the power wire is grounding out.	Check the wire connections. Contact a qualified electrician or call customer service 1-877-527-0313.
	The dimmer circuit is not compatible with the product.	Check the product page at www.HomeDepot.com for a list of compatible dimmers.
The light fixture flickers or makes a buzzing sound.	The dimming circuit is set outside the dimming range of the product.	Turn or slide the dimmer switch to adjust the light output until the flickering or buzzing stops.
	Slide the dimmer too fast.	Turn off the wall switch for more than 3 seconds, then turn back on.
Out of sync	The dimmer circuit is not compatible with the product.	Check the product page at www.HomeDepot.com for a list of compatible dimmers.
