4.Low Maintenance:







INSTALLATION GUIDE

Installing a bathroom vanity can vary depending on the specific type and design of the vanity, as well as your bathroom setup. Here are some general steps to guide you through the process:



NOTE: A drain pipe and trap are not included with this vanity.

- 1. Prepare the area: Clear out the space where the vanity will be installed. Ensure the plumbing lines are in place and ready for connection.
- **Measure the space:** Measure the dimensions of the vanity and the available space in your bathroom to ensure it will fit properly.
- 3. Turn off the water supply: Before starting any work, be sure to turn off the water supply to the bathroom.
- **4. Remove the old vanity:** If there is an existing vanity, you will need to disconnect the plumbing, remove the sink, and take out the old vanity.











Take out the A1. A2 side panels, insert the 10 accessory into the corresponding hole and tighten the screws.




STEP 2

Attention: Stop tightening the screws until they meet the rubber particles, and do not over-tighten to prevent the screws from deforming.




Take out the C, D, and E plates, insert the 10 accessory into the corresponding hole, tighten the screw, align the hole of C with the screw of D and insert it.

(Unexpected situation: If the C plate cannot be inserted, try to rotate the screw of the C plate counterclockwise to release the screw hole).



Use a screwdriver to tighten the side screws clockwise to lock the two panels.





After the panels are spliced, you can rotate the cross screw holes of the panels clockwise to lock the panels, and rotate the cross screw holes of the panels counterclockwise to unlock and remove the panels.

Take out the A1, G, F, H, and A2 plates, insert them into the corresponding holes as shown in the picture, and tighten the screws. Then stand them up, tighten all


the screws from behind.






STEP 6

Tighten the screws, then stand them up, tighten all the screws from behind.




Take out the B1 and B2 door panels, insert the 🕙 accessory into the corresponding holes first.




STEP 8

Take out the 4 hinge, put these 4 hinges into the corresponding holes, and tighten them with the ② screw.





Return to the cabinet, insert accessories 🕙 into the corresponding holes of A1 and A2.




STEP 10


Install the door panel, align the hole of hinge 4 with the hole of side panel A1, A2, and tighten them with screw 2.






Use a screwdriver to adjust the door panel.






Loosen this screw and pull the hinge back and forth to adjust the door panel's front and rear tilt, ultimately achieving snug-fitting baffle effect.




Turning this screw, the door panel can be adjusted to tilt left and right, eventually achieving vertical effect.


STEP 12

Close the hinged cap.







Install accessory on the H plate to achieve reinforcement.



STEP 14


Fix the cabinet to the wall. Use a pencil to mark locations where holes need to be drilled, then drill holes in the wall. Insert the
accessory into the holes, move the cabinet to the corresponding holes, use the 8 accessory to pass through the 9 accessory and tighten them, finally install the **(1)** accessory.





COMPLETE

- 1.Seal the Edges: To prevent water damage and ensure a clean finish, apply a bead of silicone caulk along the edges where the countertop meets the cabinet.
- 2.Attach the laundry sink: Secure the solid surface laundry sink on the cabinet.

CARE & MAINTACE

Solid surface countertop are made from a mixture of acrylic, polyester resins, and natural minerals, making them highly durable and resistant to scratches, stains, and impact damage.

1.Regular Cleaning:

Clean the countertop regularly with a mild, non-abrasive cleaner and a soft cloth or sponge. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that can damage the glossy surface.

2.Avoid Scratches:

Use gentle cleaning tools and avoid abrasive scrubbers to prevent scratches on the glossy surface. Be cautious when placing objects on the countertop surface to avoid damage.

3.Stain Removal:
