

WARNING:



- Ensure the batteries are installed correctly according to polarity (+ and -).
- Do not mix old and new batteries, different brands or types of batteries, such as alkaline, carbon-zinc, or rechargeable batteries.


Compare all parts in the package with the Package Contents list. If any part appears missing or damaged, do not install this product. Contact customer support.

ABOUT WIRELESS EQUIPMENT

These sensors require Defiant® Smart Security Kit SKU# 1010 516 033 (sold separately). For more detailed operation and installation, please follow the Security Kit's instruction.

Operation

- Add the Security Kit SKU# 1010 516 033 (sold separately) in the Hubspace app. Follow the Security Kit's instruction.
- **2** Press "+" in the app and follow the instructions in the Hubspace app for adding additional sensors.

Sensor's Bracket must be removed first when pairing them with the siren hub.

- To manually Pair a Sensor: Press and hold the Pairing Button of the siren hub for 2 seconds first, then press and hold the Pairing button of the sensor for 5 seconds and then release. After pairing is successful, the siren hub will beep once.
- Remove all known Sensors: Press and hold the reset button of the Siren Hub for 10 seconds or use the mobile app.



Installation

IMPORTANT:




- The distance between Door/Window Sensor (AA) and Magnet (BB) must not exceed 1.2 inch in closed state.
- □ This sensor should not be mounted on a metal frame
- This sensor should only be installed indoors
- The Door/Window Sensor (AA) can be mounted on a door or window.




Remove the Bracket from the Door/Window Sensor (AA) by following the direction of the unlock

marked on the side of Door/ Window Sensor (AA).



 Determine your placement position and attach the Bracket with either Screws (CC) or preinstalled double-sided adhesive tape.





WARNING: The double-sided adhesive tape might rip off paint. The adhesive tape is one time use only.

 Pull out the battery insulator pull tab to activate the battery.




 Hang the Door/Window Sensor(AA) on the Bracket by following the direction of lock marked in the side of Door/Window sensor (AA).



Installation (continued)

 Door/Window Sensor (AA) installation completed. Please put the Magnet (BB) near the Door/Window Sensor (AA) with the distance not exceed 1.2 inch in closed state of door/window.



Replace the Batteries

The app will notify you when a device's battery gets low. To replace the battery, please disarm the system first to avoid unintended tamper alarm.

- Disarm the system.
- Remove the door/window sensor from the bracket.
- Use a screwdriver to open the battery cover.
- Remove the old battery and replace with new CR2032 battery.
- Close the battery cover.
- Hang the door/window sensor on the bracket.
