


USE AND CARE GUIDE

LOCK NUT WRENCH



- Spring-loaded Jaw Automatically Adjusts to Fit Most Sink Strainer Lock Nut
- For Removing and Installing Sink Strainer
- Dual Material Cushion Grip

Read All Instructions Carefully Before Using:

- 1. Beneath the sink, loosen the drain pipe slip nuts
- 2. Remove drain pipe from sink strainer. Note: To adjust diameter of lock nut wrench, simply use your fingers to apply pressure to hinged jaw
- 3. Insert a basket strainer wrench into the base of the basket to prevent it from turning. Grip strainer lock nut with wrench and turn counter-clockwise until loose
- 4. Repair or replace strainer (if replacing sink strainer, follow the manufacturers' directions for installation), re-tighten strainer with the lock nut wrench until tight. Be careful not to over tighten
- 5. Reconnect the drain pipe and tighten slip nuts
- 6. Check for leaks
