


### INSTALLING CROWN MOULDING:

- 1. Surface must be dry before installation. For best results, install on freshly painted dry walls; or, wipe walls with rubbing alcohol prior to installation. Do not use household cleaners or water, as they leave slippery residue.
- 2. Recommended: Use a laser level or chalk line to ensure moulding is straight.
- 3. Remove backing paper from the 1" **permanent adhesive** strip on the bottom back of the moulding. Press and hold moulding firmly against surface for 30 seconds. Allow 72 hours for adhesive tape to cure.
- 4. Not all walls are straight, so apply caulk where necessary to fill in any gaps and joints. Remove excess caulk, let dry and sand, if necessary. Make sure surface is clean and dry before painting.


NOTE: When installing moulding for Indirect Lighting, a minimum 6" distance must be kept from ceiling.





- 2. Recommended: Use a laser level or chalk line to ensure moulding is straight.
- 3. Remove backing paper from the 1" **permanent adhesive** strip on the bottom back of the moulding. Press and hold moulding firmly against surface for 30 seconds. Allow 72 hours for adhesive tape to cure.
- 4. Not all walls are straight, so apply caulk where necessary to fill in any gaps and joints.

  Remove excess caulk, let dry and sand, if necessary. Make sure surface is clean and dry before painting.
