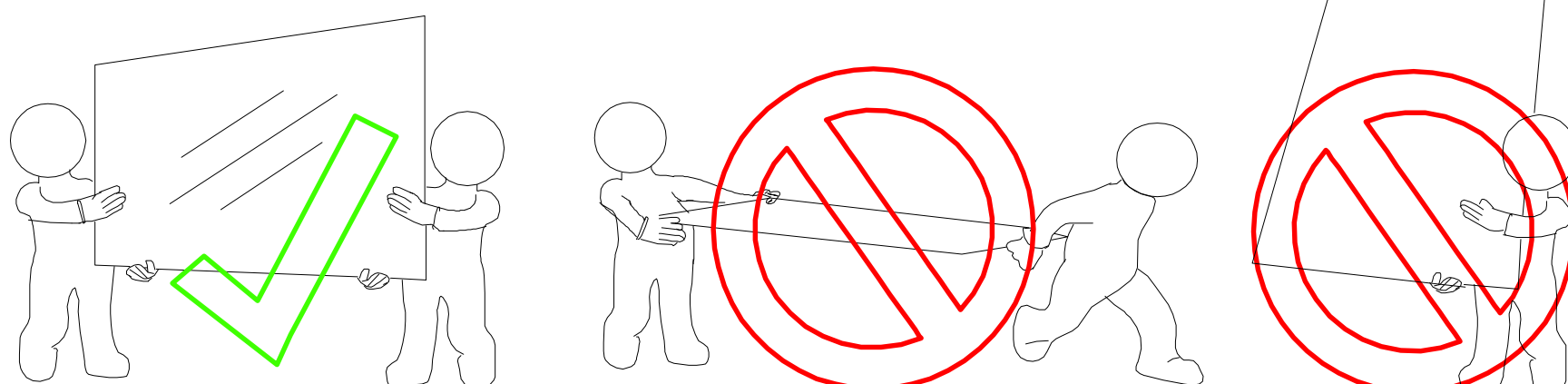
### CAUTION

- Always wear safety glasses and gloves while handling.
- Always follow the installation instructions.
- Inspect glass for damage before installation.
- Extreme caution should be taken while handling the glass during installation as the tempered glass may shatter if in contact with a hard surface.
- Do not cut or modify the tempered glass as it will shatter if cut.
- Carefully remove product from packaging and keep packaging until installation is complete.
- Inspect all parts for damage or missing; if there is damage or part missing to the unit prior to installation, please contact customer service at the number provided in this guide.
- Cover the drain with tape to prevent the loss of small parts.
- The shower base and finished walls should be installed before beginning the shower door installation.
- During the installation, protect the shower floor with a drop cloth to avoid damage.
- This product should be installed by two people who are familiar with construction requirements. Professional installation is recommended!
- Keep this installation manual for future reference.

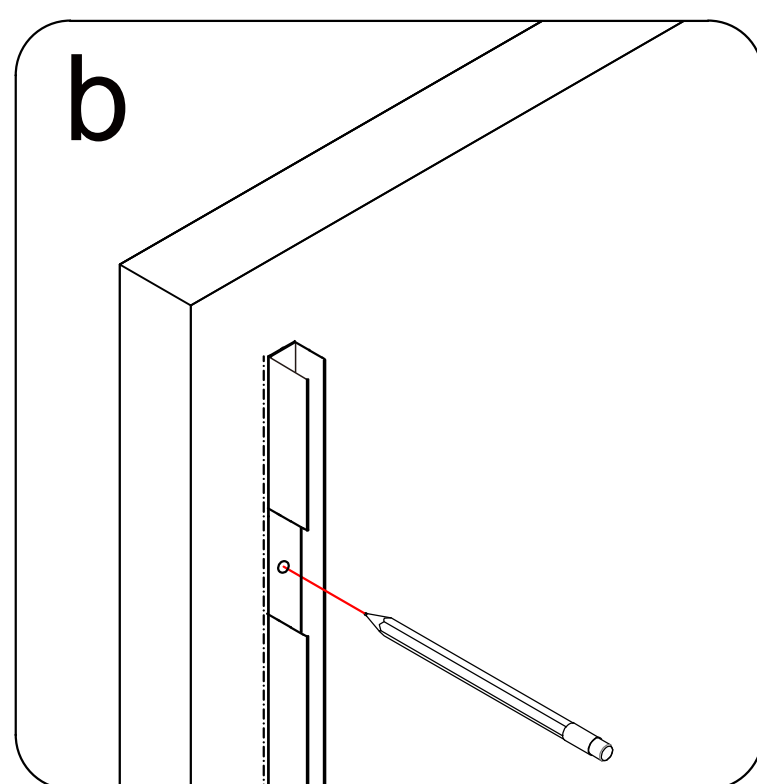
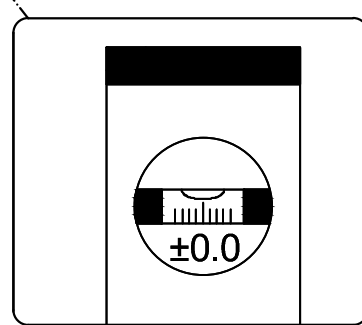
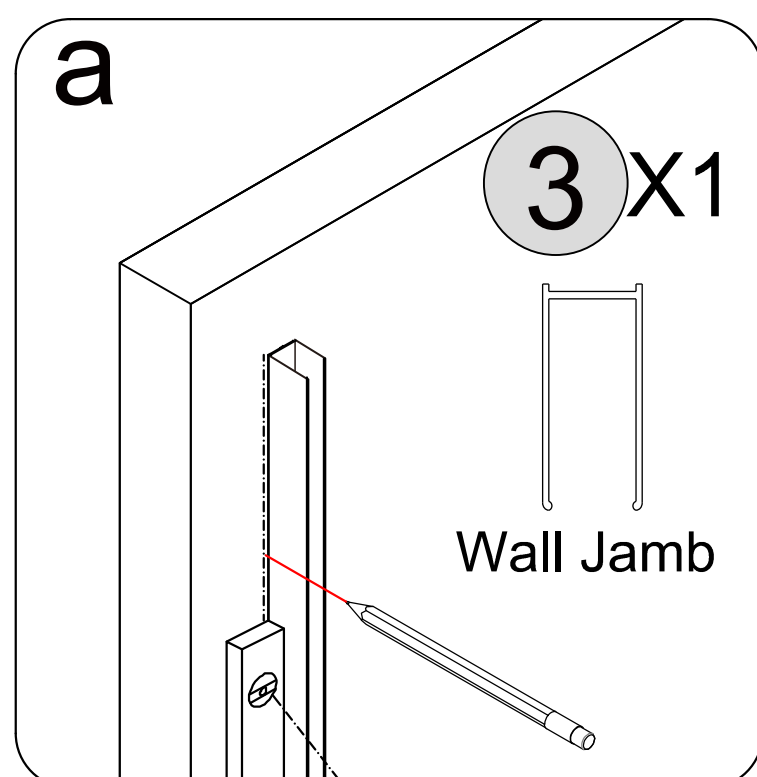

### Wall Jamb Installation

NOTE

Confirm the Wall jamb is plumb with a level before marking the location of the holes for drilling.



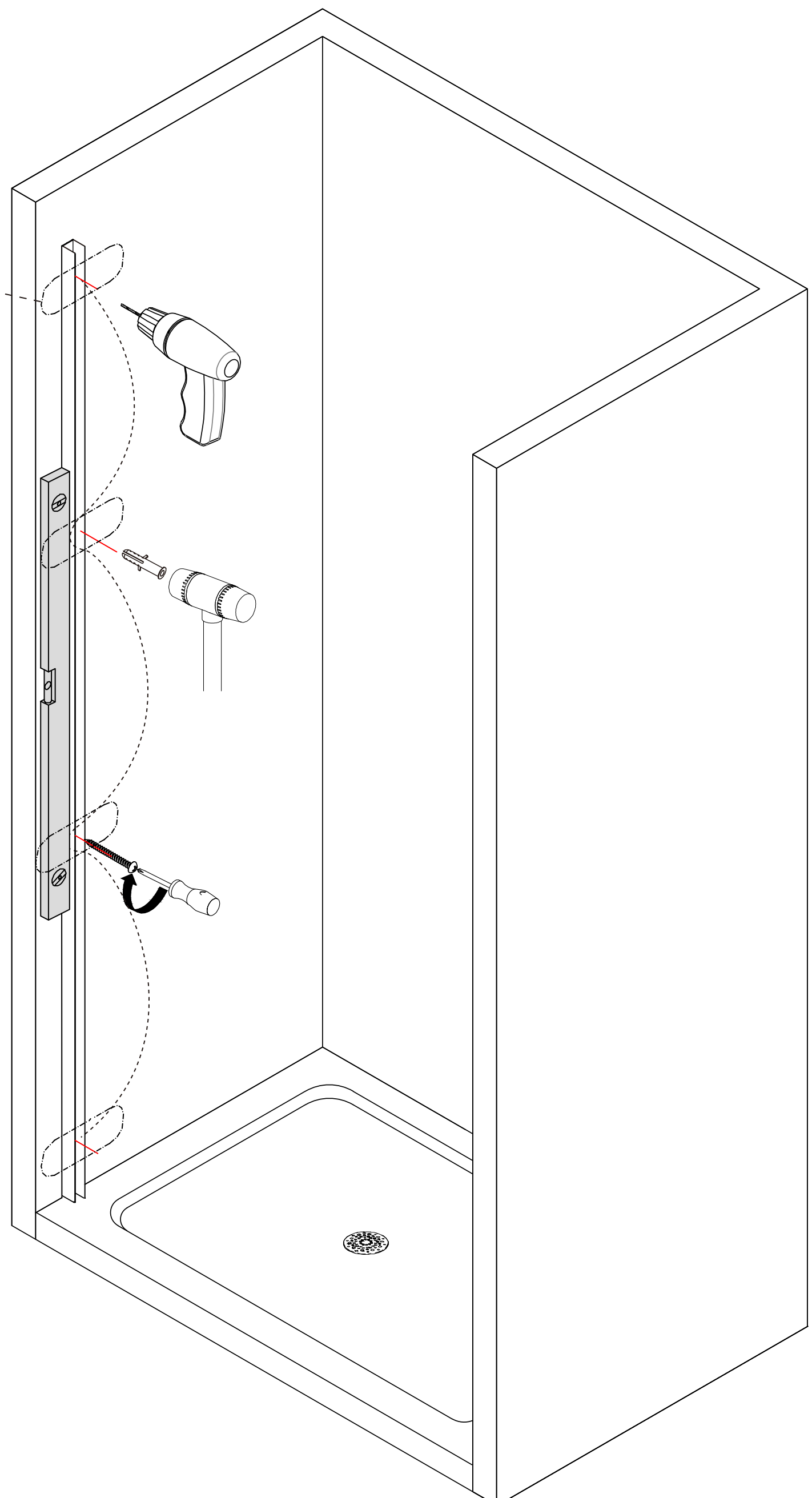
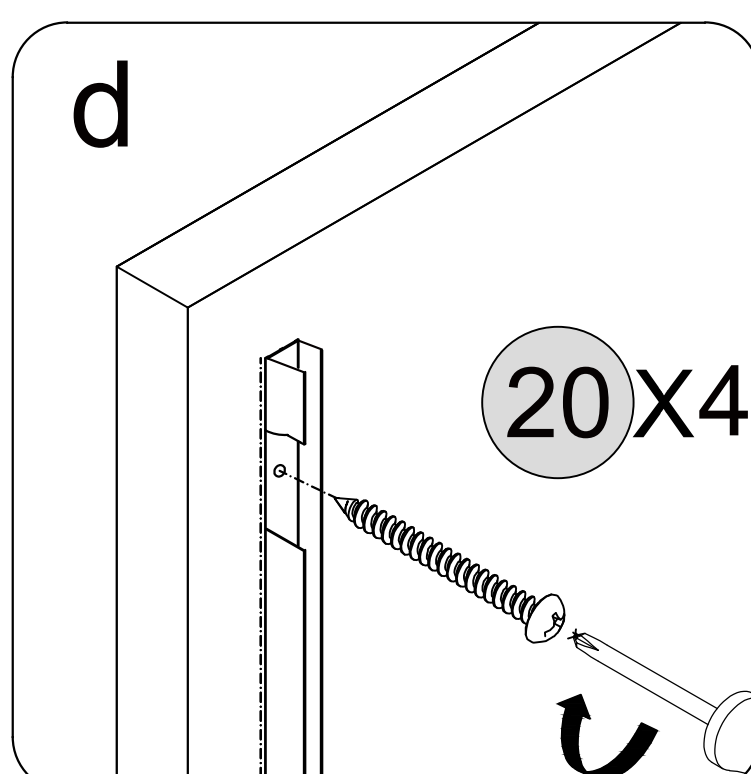
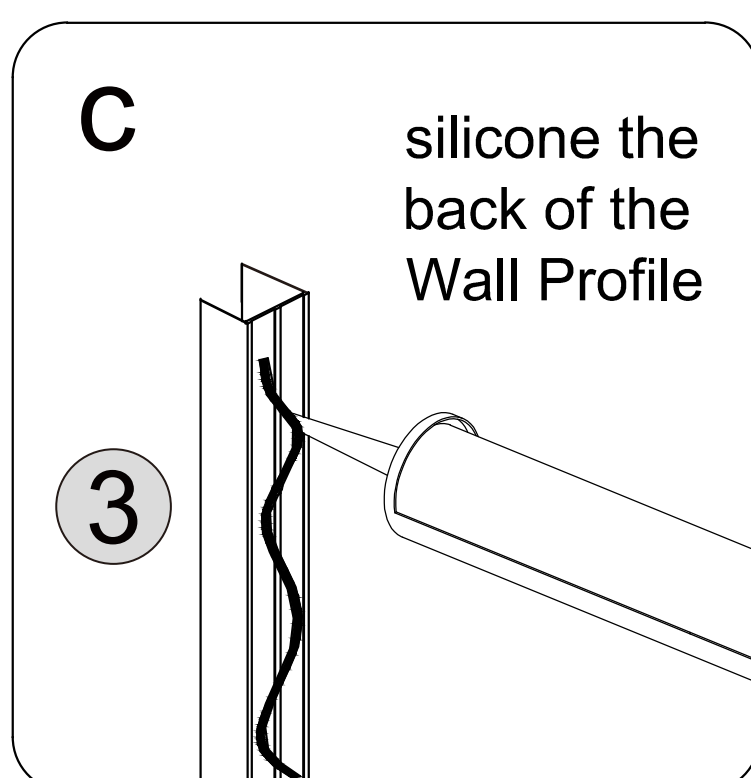
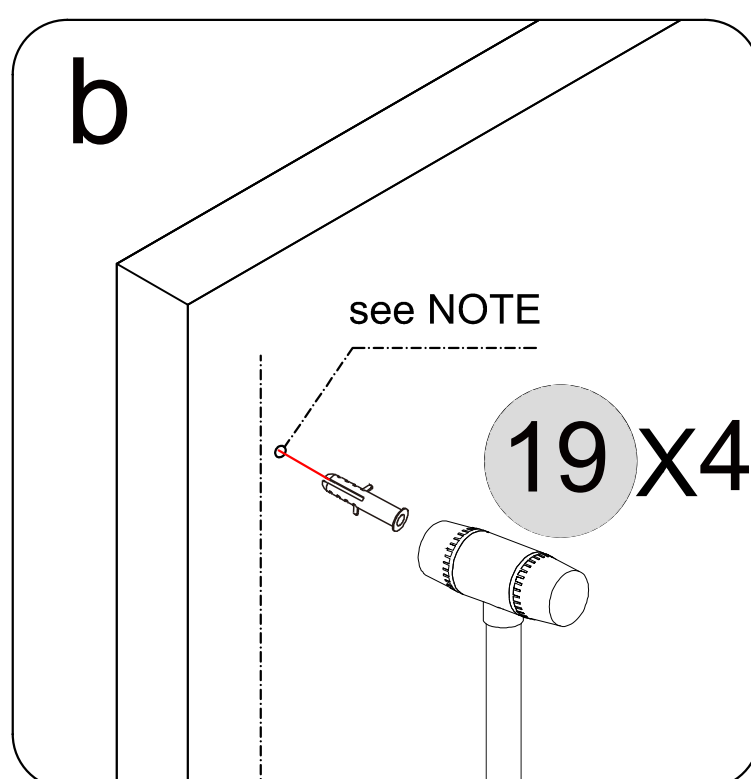
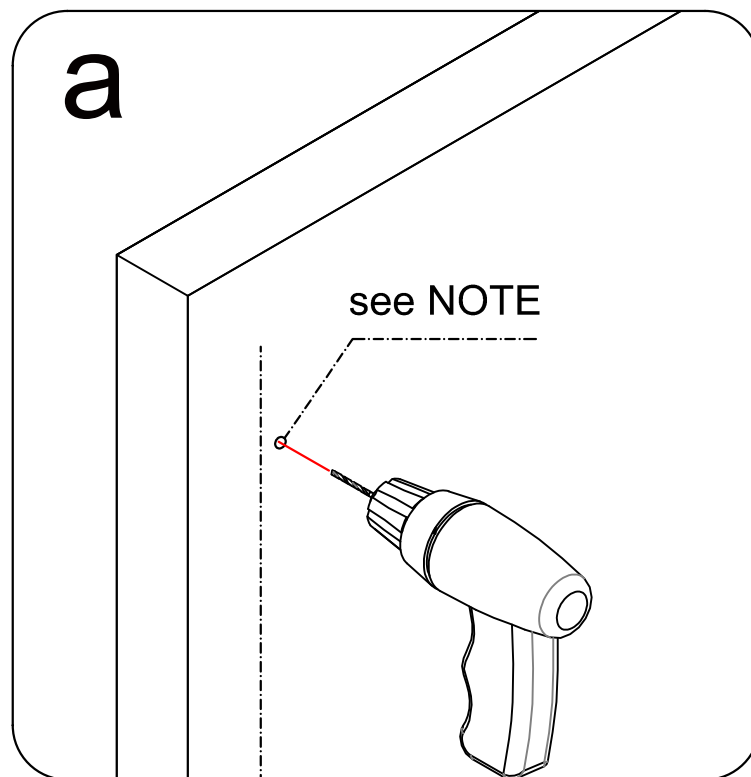

Center the Wall jamb (3) on the Threshold.  
Leave 20mm [25/32"] from edge of shower pan.

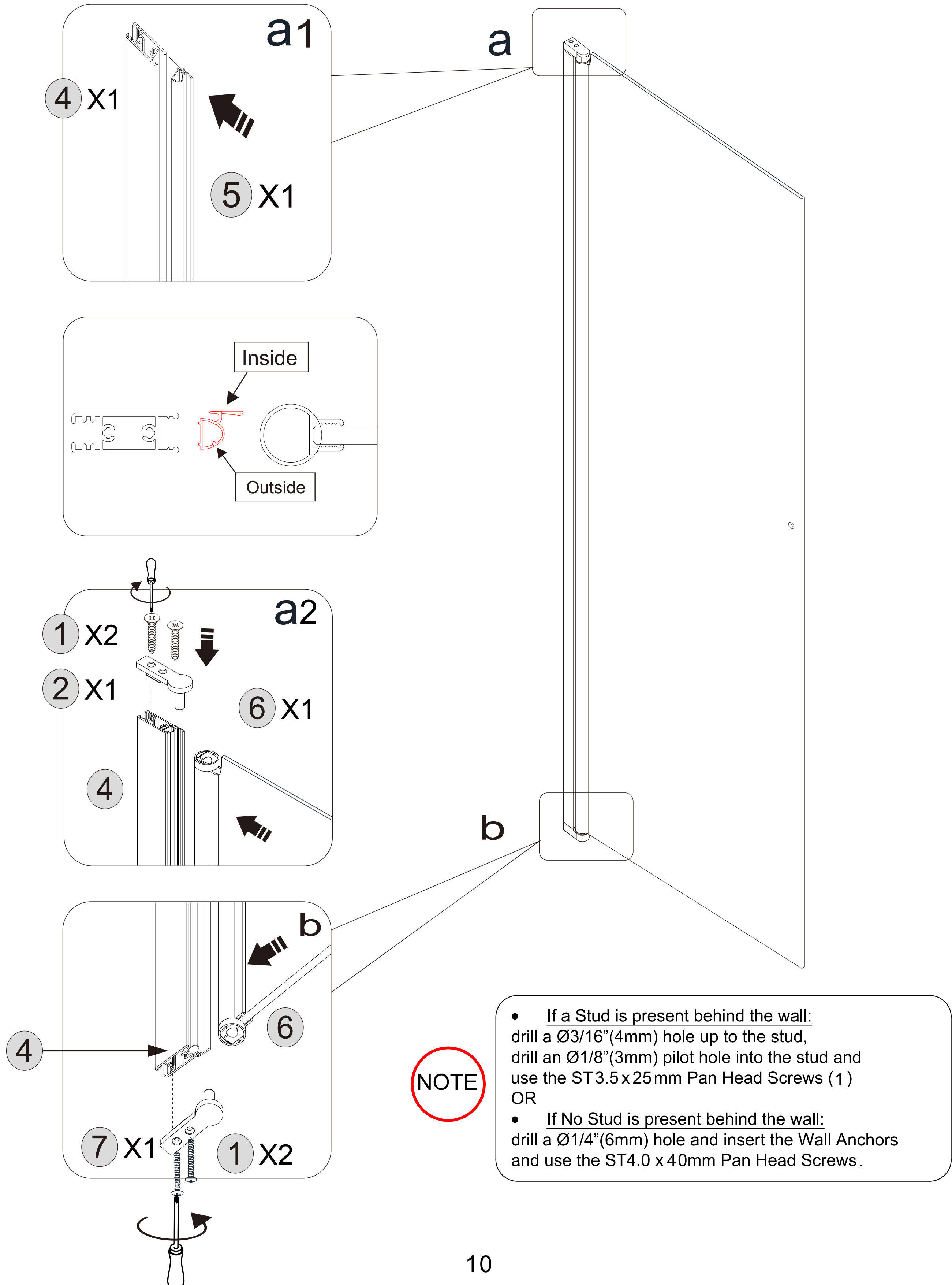
### Wall Jamb Installation



**NOTE**

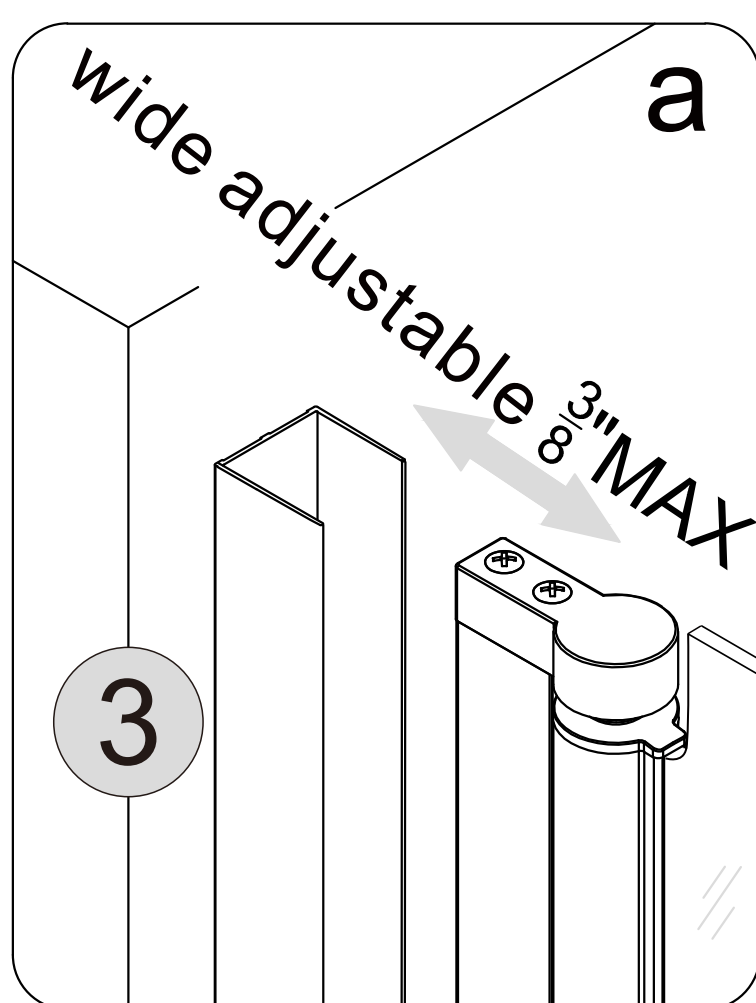
- If a Stud is present behind the wall:  
drill a Ø3/16" (4mm) hole up to the stud,  
drill an Ø1/8" (3mm) pilot hole into the stud and  
use the ST4.0 x 40mm Pan Head Screws (20)  
OR
- If No Stud is present behind the wall:  
drill a Ø1/4" (6mm) hole and insert the Wall Anchors  
and use the ST4.0 x 40mm Pan Head Screws.

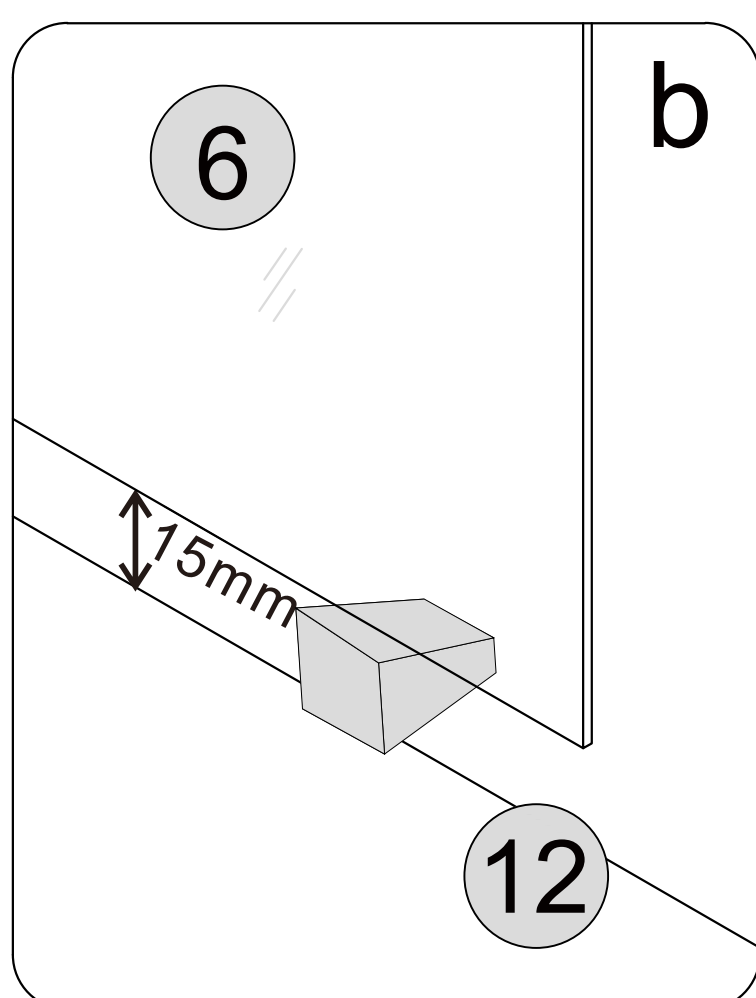
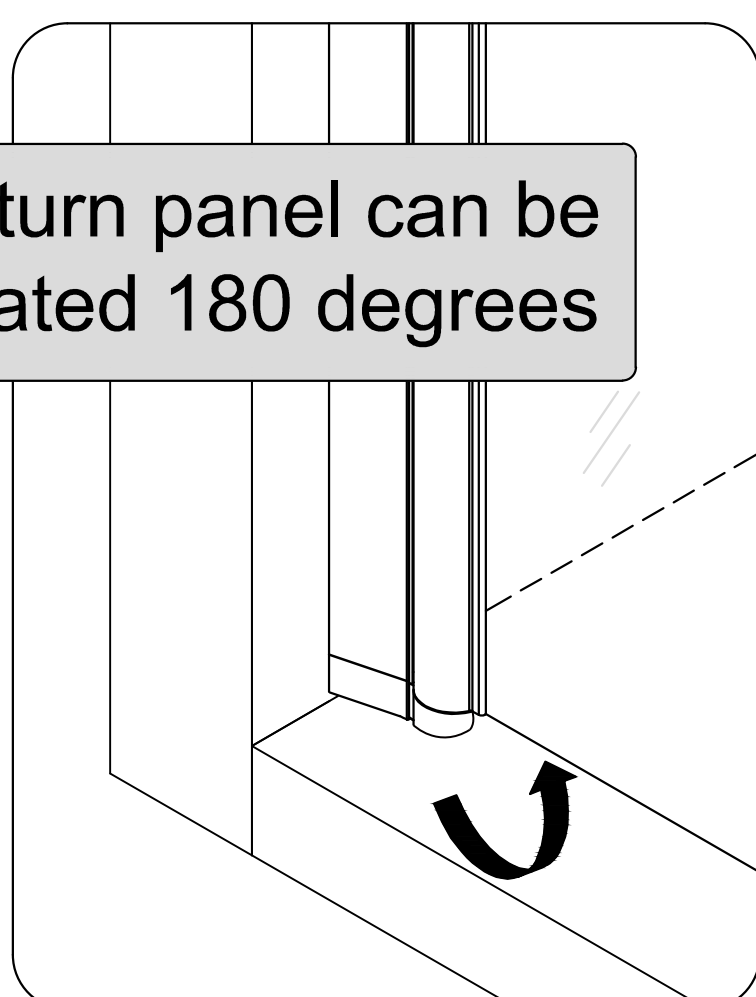

## Door panel Installation



Return panel can be rotated 180 degrees

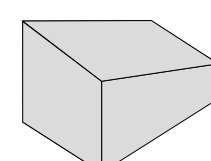


NOTE

The Door panel Profiles can be adjusted up to  $\frac{3}{8}$ " within the Wall Jamb for overall width or to correct for out-of-plumb conditions within the model size. Screw them together after making final adjustments.

NOTE

Place wood shim(12) onto the threshold to provide proper spacing beneath the door glass.

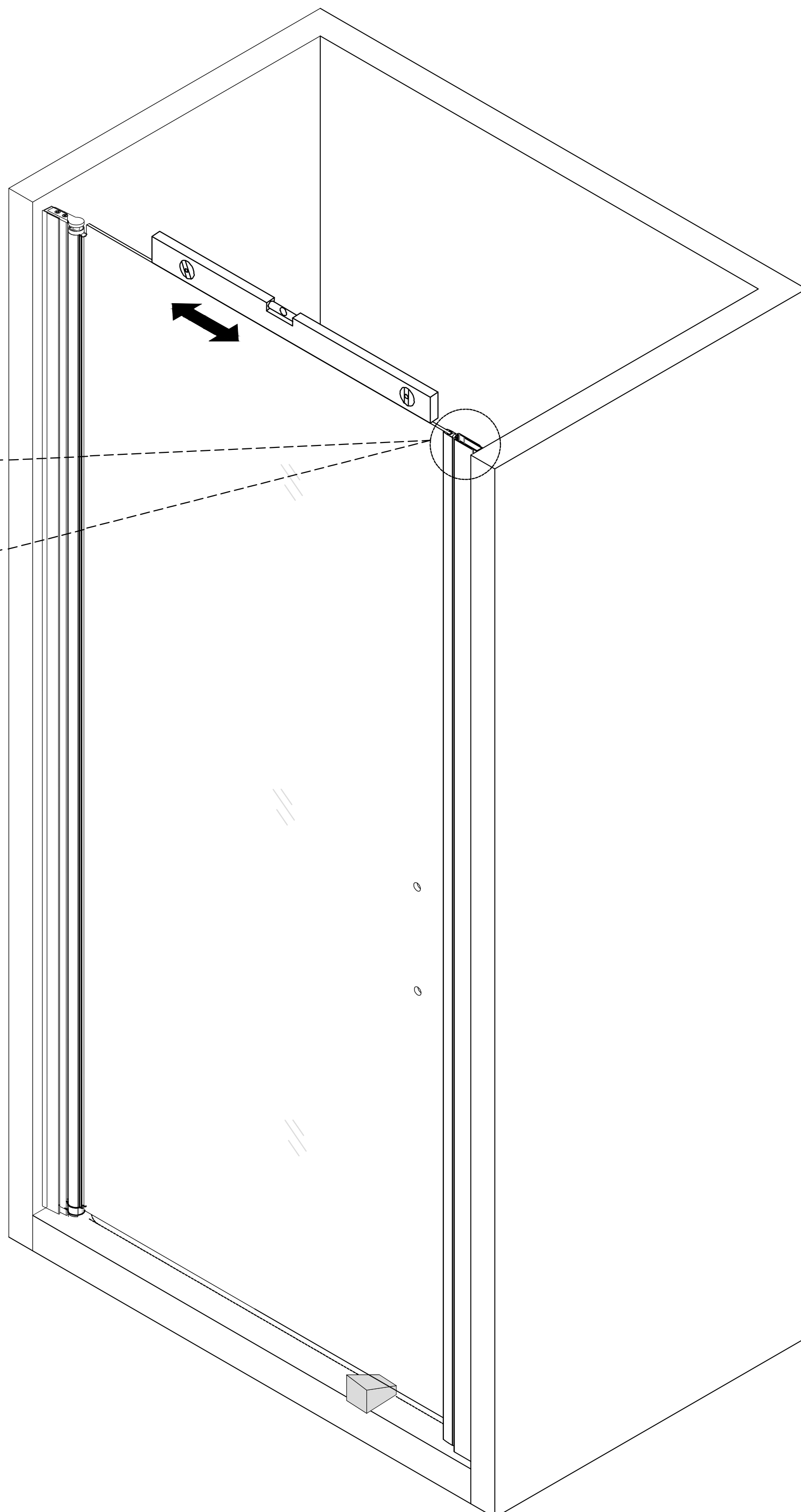
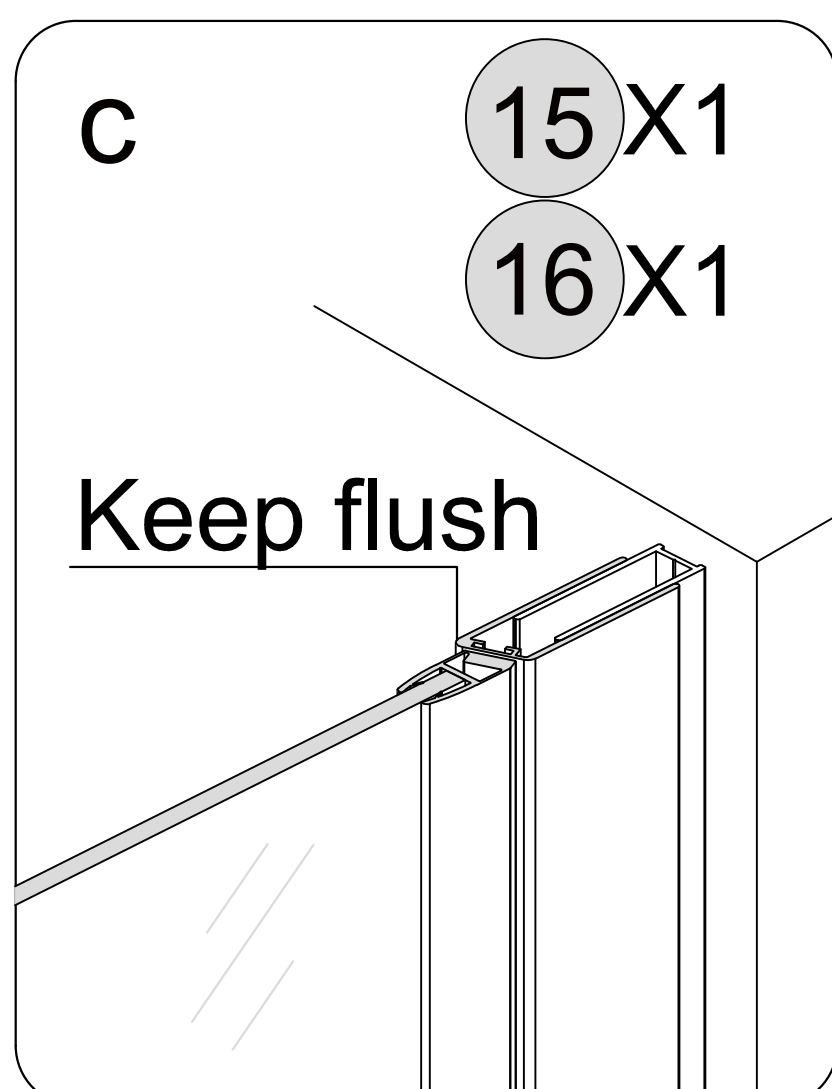
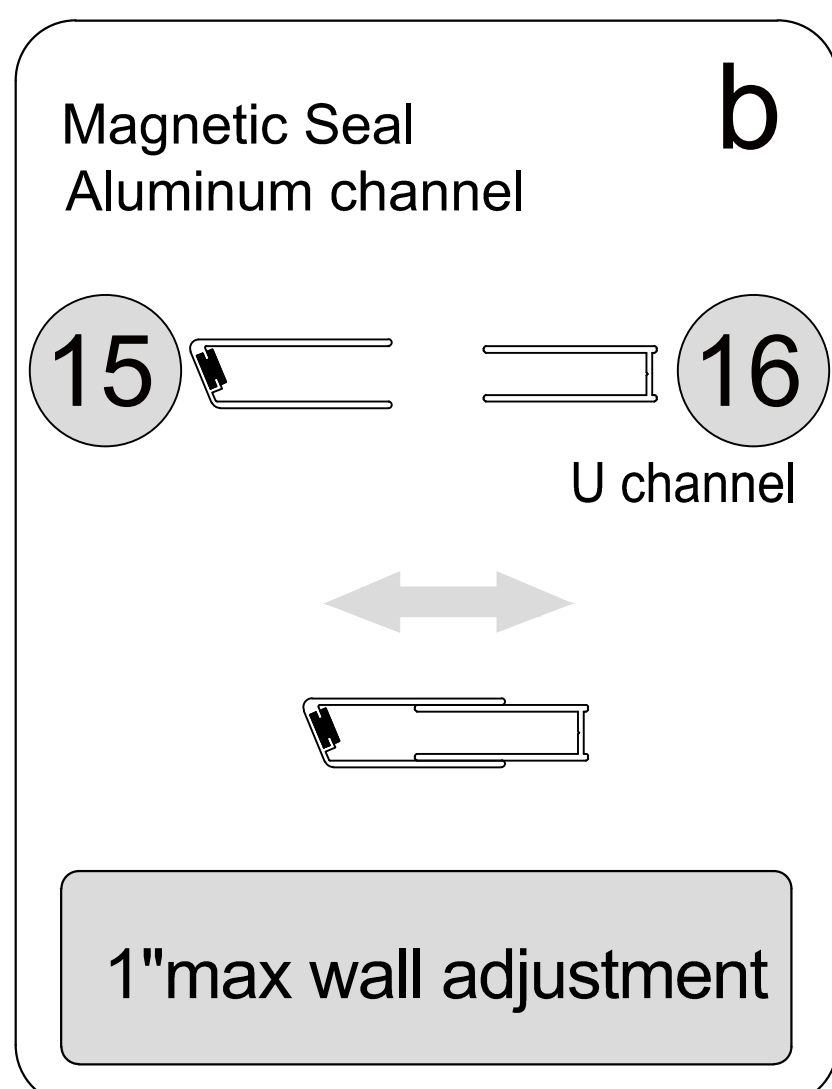
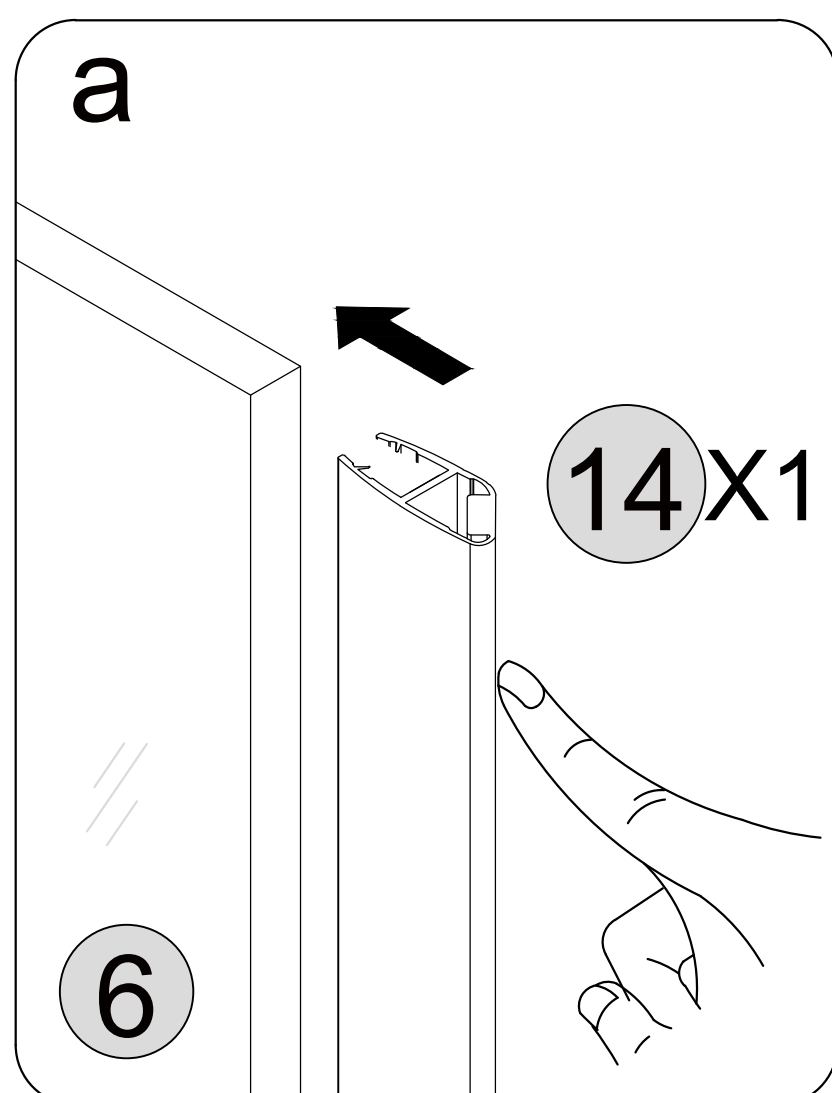

- 1、Magnetic strip Install to door panel.
- 2、Put 14, 15 ,16 together before fasten the glass door,make all these parts keep flush.



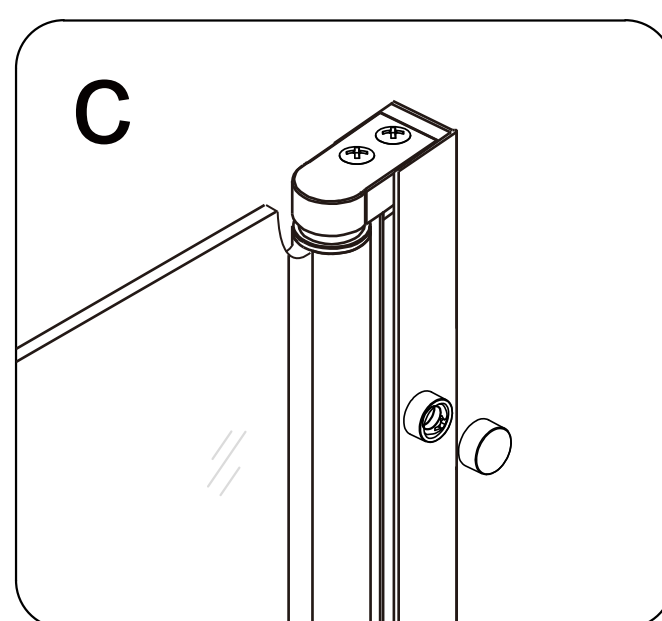
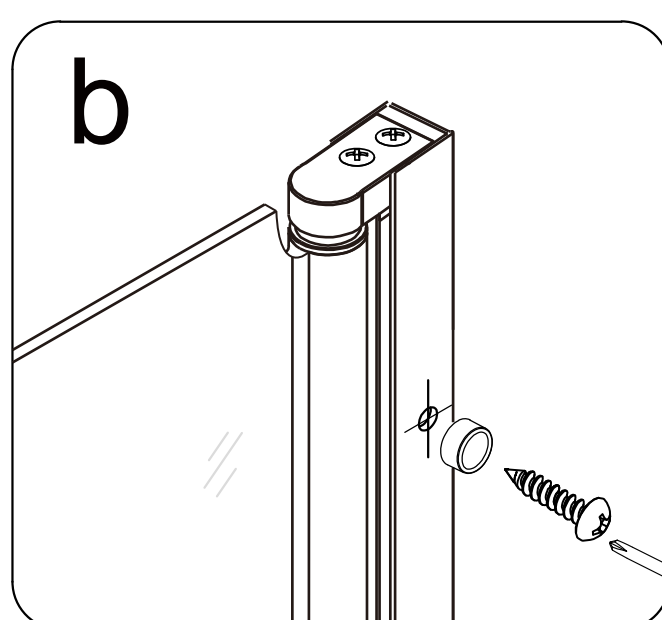
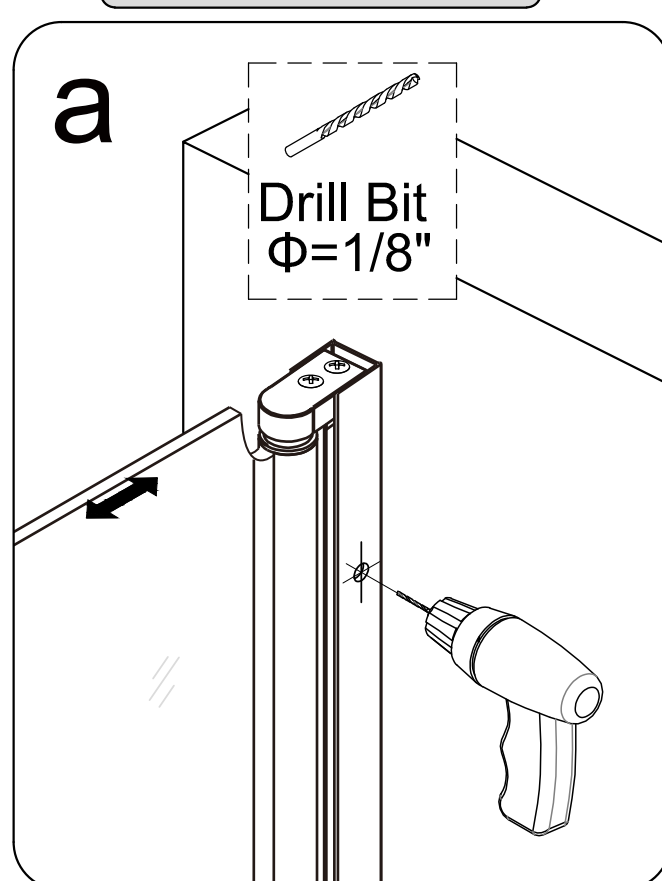

### Fixed the door panel

**NOTE**

After final adjustments, drill  $\varnothing 1/8"$  holes in the Wall Jamp (3).  
Drill only through the first layer of the Door panel Profile and install the ST4.0x12mm Pan Head Screws (21) using the Decorative Covers and Washers (17)

Center the Magnetic Seal Aluminum channel(15) and U channel (16) on the Threshold.

### U channel Installation



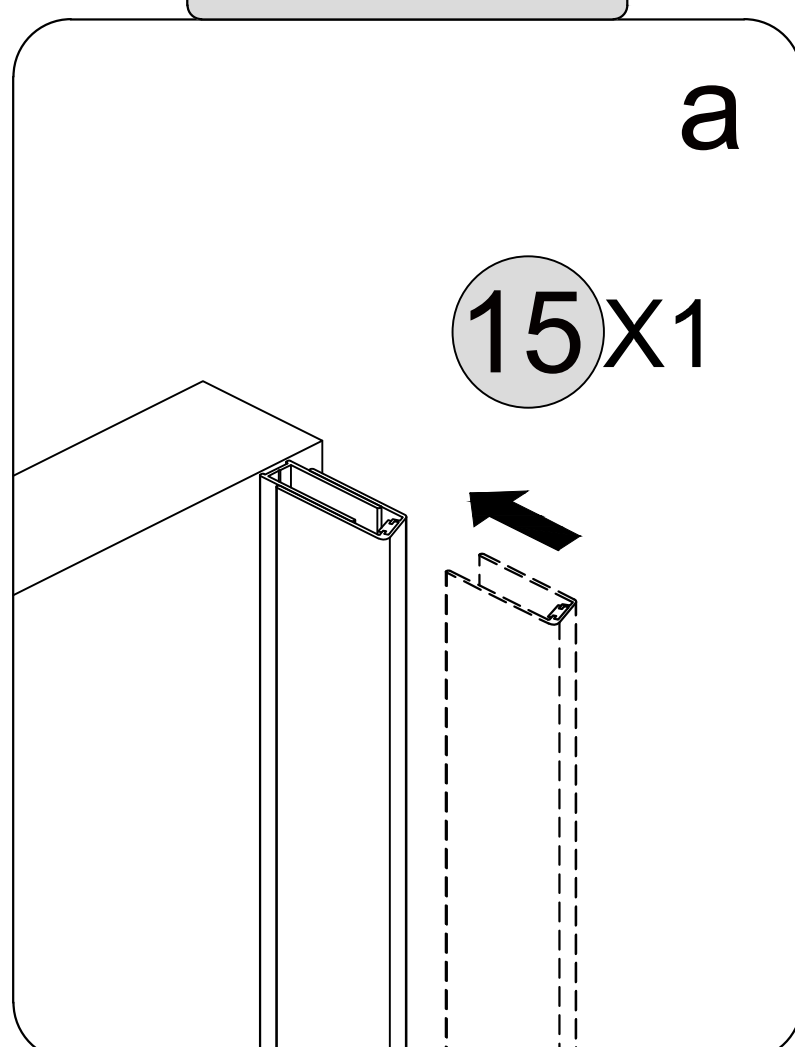
NOTE

- If a Stud is present behind the wall:  
drill a Ø3/16" (4mm) hole up to the stud,  
drill an Ø1/8" (3mm) pilot hole into the stud and  
use the ST4.0 x 40mm Pan Head Screws (20)  
OR
- If No Stud is present behind the wall:  
drill a Ø1/4" (6mm) hole and insert the Wall Anchors (19)  
and use the ST4.0 x 40mm Pan Head Screws (20).

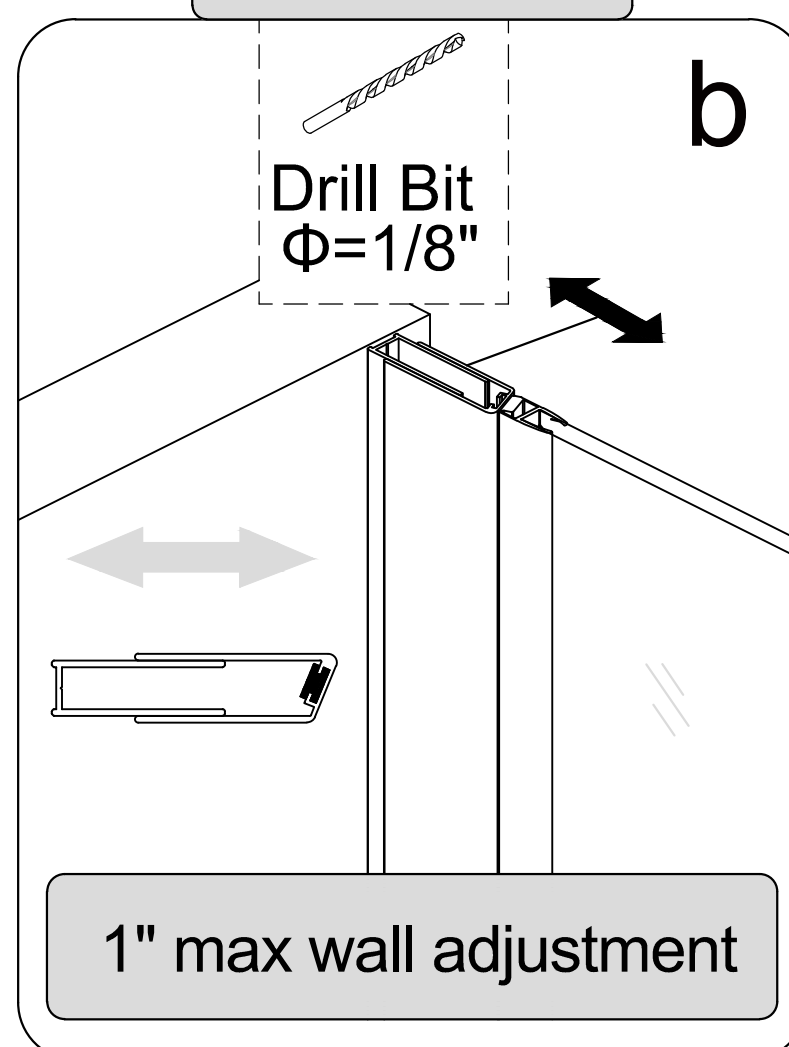

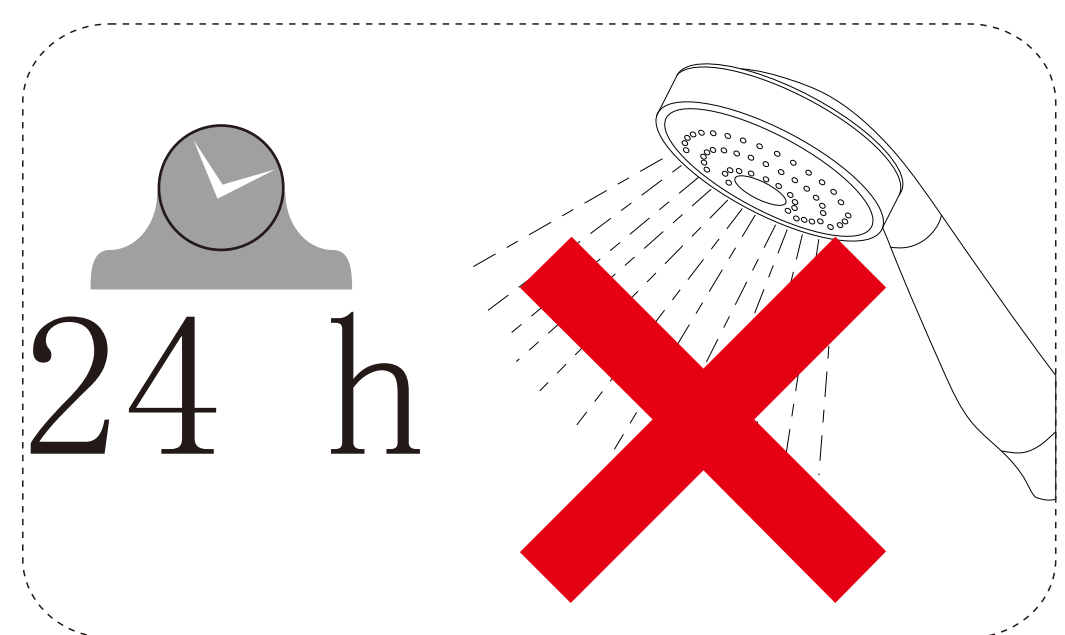
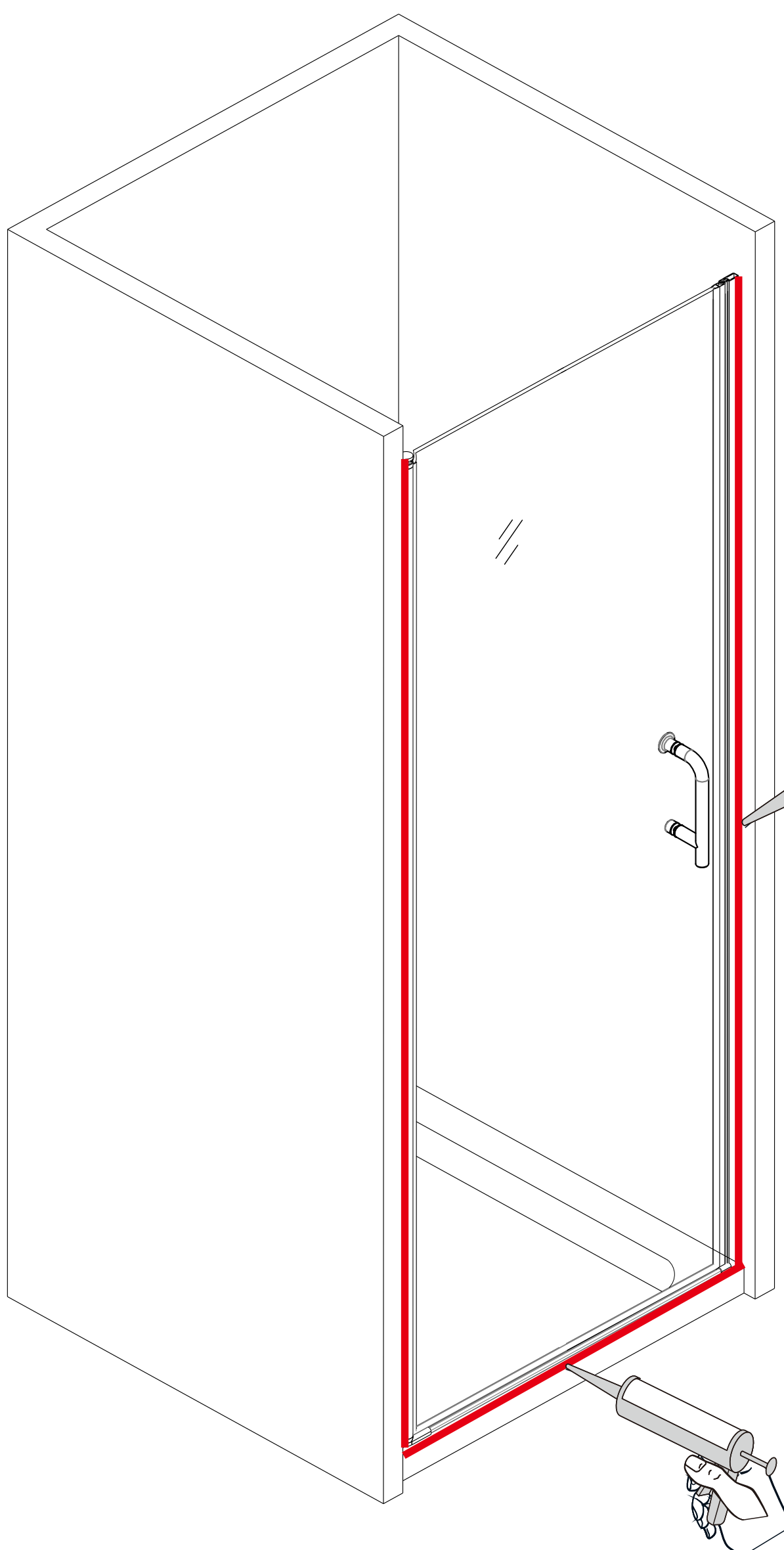
The surfaces need to be clean and free of debris before applying silicone.

NOTE

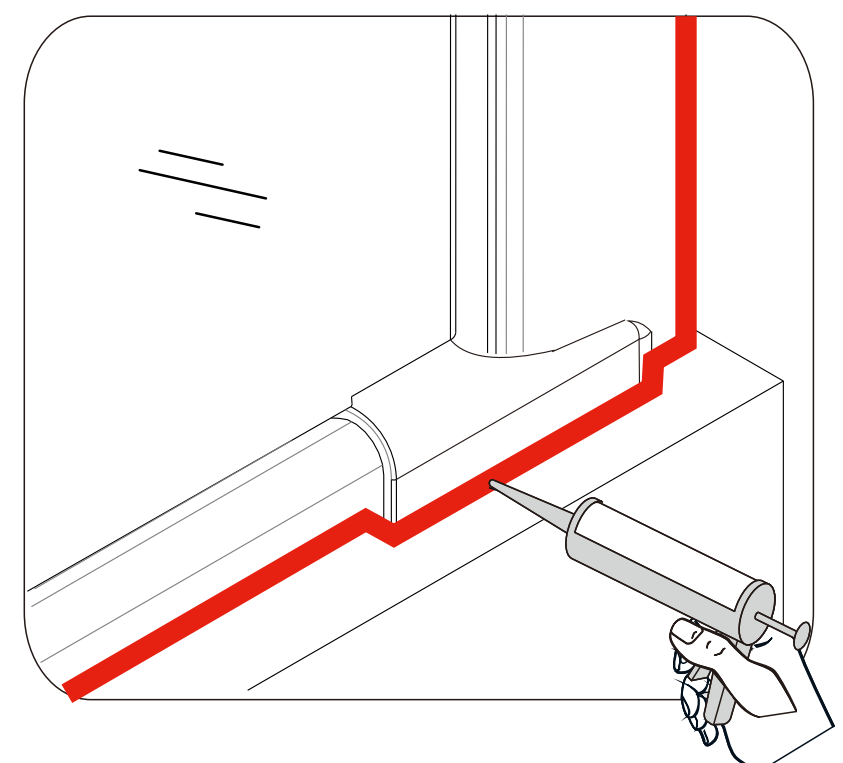
Ensure that the Shower door closes tightly and opens smoothly.  
**Apply a good quality silicone sealant along the wall Jamb(3)&(9)and Water seal (16) .**



**Allow 24 hours for the silicone to cure before using the shower.**



Apply Silicone Sealant,(not supplied).

Troubleshooting		
Problem/Symptom	Suggested Solution	Page(s)
Missing parts	*Check all shipping/packaging material for missing parts/components. *If not found, please contact us to order factory part replacement.	2.3
Door is not operaing smoothly	*Check the magentic seal (F)for proper trimming and installation. * Confirm the sweep seal (A) is tightly secured to the bottom of Door Glass	10-15
Water leakage	*Check all the pvc seals for proper trimming and installation. *Check the alu. threshold installed properly and secured with silicone.	16-18
Handle rattles during operation	*Confirm the pvc gaskets are present and the handle is tightly secured to the glass.	15
